### Textiles

#### What should I already know?

- I know how to join felt and other materials to a piece of base material.
- I know what a running and over stitch are.

#### Knowledge

- I can explain the difference between the function and visual appearance of a product.
- I can describe a variety of decorative sewing techniques.

#### Skills

- I can cut, shape and join fabric to make a simple garment.
- I can measure, tape or pin, cut and join fabric with some accuracy
- I can use running stick, back stitch, over stitch and zigzag stitch to join two pieces of fabric together.
- I can hide the finishing knot.
- I can sew a button, bead, sequin or pipe cleaner onto a piece of fabric.
- I can embroider shapes and patterns into a piece of fabric and use appliqué to add decoration to a piece of fabric.

#### Vocabulary:

<b>join</b>	Attach two separate pieces of fabric together, leaving a little space in between.
<b>functionality</b>	The ability to perform a task or function
<b>hidden knot</b>	To hide your knot between 2 pieces of fabric.
<b>visually appealing</b>	To create a product that is attractive to the audience.
